I haven't emailed you concerning the Peru trip and container as there hasn't been any news due to the dock strike. We did accomplish many great things for the Lord while we were in Peru and we also faced much opposition from the enemy as he tried to discourage us and the work that God has called us to.

The people who were living in the stadium have left and gone back to living in homes. There are still a few people left who are homeless, but they are getting back to work and life as normal as they can for them!

They will be doing a huge outreach using approximately 250 volunteers from Peru and the states, reaching out to this area in the third week of January. The new church location is adjacent to where the outreach was planned for!

I just talked to OB in Peru and the container is in customs! They checked the manifest yesterday and say it is all there and intact. If all goes well, we will have access to the container next week. I am supposed to get more info on Tuesday.

Please pray that all goes well with the container as it will be able to be used in the upcoming outreach! Continue to pray for the people in Peru and for the new church plant. Marco says that most of the people who were attending the church when he held it in the stadium are still coming to the new location and he is making more and more inroads there everyday!
