

I'm getting ready to get on a bus and head to the DR capitol, spend the night and then get on a bus to Port Au Prince. I've been introduced to a missionary from America who has a compound there and has secured passage for us to go in with a small team and do some assessing.

The people I am staying with are confident that these are good people who know what they are doing and are very cautious. They have been in contact with one of their compounds and they will be picking us up at the bus depot and from there, take us into their compound. From there we will venture out as we can and see what we can do to help out and to formulate some teams. Unfortunately we will have very little time to do much more than that at this time.

I will then travel back to the DR and meet with Pastor Vic and we will fly back to the US late Tuesday night as we begin to figure things out. I will spend the night with him in Miami and then drive home on Wednesday morning.

There have been quite a few changes with the Lataillades. They are both in a hospital in Miami and are recovery from surgery as well as being possibly prepped for more. Barb has called us here at the house. We decided it best for Agape, Rachel and Mike to get back to Miami ASAP, so we worked feverishly to get them on a plane this afternoon and they will be reunited with their family tonight. Thanks to Vic and his church for all of their help with getting them picked and driving them around Miami tonight. They have been a huge blessing to us on this trip!

My main goal coming down here was to help Agape and Rachel get to their parents, not knowing they were getting medivac'd out. I ended up helping them out of the DR and getting them to Miami to see their family. God is good and knows way more than me! Please keep the Lataillade's in your prayers as they will have a hard road ahead of them.
