

Just a quick note as I'm really swamped right now. I'm leaving for Miami around noon to fly to the Dominican Republic with Agape Lataillade, the son of our missionary in Haiti whose house collapsed on him and his wife. We will be spending the night at his in laws and then heading for the border in the morning, somehow meeting up with his sister and her husband. There will be 6 or 7 of us going into Haiti.

We have secured a van for us to travel in, but could really use a pickup or similar vehicle to haul supplies, please pray for this and if you have any leads as to how to get one, contact me immediately at 941-915-9560. My flight leaves Miami at 6:30 and then I'll be on line hopefully tonight.

I have contacted the Haitian Consulate in Chicago and Washington D.C. and both of them have assured me that with my American Passport I will be able to take vehicles and supplies across the border, but one can never be sure until we are actually at the border. Please pray for this as well.

Patrick and Barb are both safe. There is a good chance that Agape Flights is bringing Barb out of Haiti today because she needs surgery on her foot, which is broke. Patrick is supposedly going to stay; he is fine, just bruised up. Continue to keep them in your prayers.

Please pray for traveling mercies and safety for all of us and most importantly for the Lord's guidance in this endeavor. Continue to lift up all those affected by this massive devastation. Many lives have been and will continue to be affected. Pray that the Lord would use us to share His love as we continue to be Jesus' hands and feet to a lost and dying world.

Many have contacted me about joining in our efforts. Stay tuned, this will be a long haul. I will be assessing the needs and with other churches and ministries, deciding what the best plan will be. We will be working closely with Patrick, he is a native and very familiar with the area and what can be done and when. Please be patient and keep all of this in your prayers.
