

Peru Trip 1 Arrival

For those of you who thought I was heading to Texas, we were all fooled!! I am in Peru to help assess the needs of the earthquake victims. We flew into Lima late last night and have spent the day today getting things prepared to head out in the morning.

We are at the Calvary Chapel Bible College of Peru and have met with the church and ministry leaders here to get a feel for what they've been going through and what their vision is.

We will be taking off early tomorrow morning to a town called Canete where Pastor Jaime has a small Calvary Chapel outreach. This town was on the outskirts of the earthquake and suffered a lot of damage, but not as much as the epicenter. On Saturday we will head out about 2 hours farther south to the epicenter to survey that area as well.

Please pray for clear direction from God as to what He would have us do and who He'd have us meet up with. Pray for safety as we travel and stay in these hard hit areas. Pray that we'd be an example of Jesus love in all that we do. Pray that we'd be lead as to exactly what God wants His church to do to help with the long term relief efforts of this region. Pray most of all that God's kingdom would be greatly expanded as the people of Peru are drawn to God by those who come to share the love of Jesus with them.
