

Daytona Beach-Holly Hill Flood Relief-We've Arrived

We have just arrived in Daytona Beach, the Holly Hill area. This area was covered by about 30" of water this past week due to flash flooding from all of the rain that hit here. Holly Hill is a poorer town and most people do not live in a flood zone so they don't have any flood insurance. Today was really the first day they were able to get back to their homes.

We are going to begin helping out with the clean up tomorrow morning, (we just watched Saturday night church from our home church live via the web!!). The city is going to send anyone who needs help or is willing to help our way and we have also been talking to the local volunteer coordinating agency and will be working with them as well.

We are set up at the United Brethren In Christ Church of Holly Hill. They have a nice area for accommodations, dorm style rooms, each with a bathroom and shower. There is a small kitchen and a large commercial kitchen. All are at our disposal!

We are here through Monday evening as I have to get back home for my son's graduation. We will be returning the following week, but there will be locals here to help with the cleanup.

There is a huge need for volunteers and cleaning supplies. If you can help in any way, let us know.
